Ghana's 66Th Independence Celebration in Ho, Western Togoland

Since the announcement of the venue for Ghana's 66 Independence Day celebrations in Ho, the Governing council of Western Togoland launched an investigation on reasons for choosing the area.

To give more credence to this lame assumption, the government of the republic of Ghana has resort to hurriedly gazette and raising the standard of some chiefs and giving them fat envelopes to grace the occasion and have them sign some documents to portray a kind of agreement and rejection of the Western Togoland statehood.

The vanguard for Western Togoland independence is the Homeland Study Group Foundation who have a representation in the UNPO based in Brussels, this fact is very well known to all bodies of the United Nations Organization as well as various right groups and we do have any express information from the leadership of HSGF to have any one sign any paper and appear at Ghana independence celebration to make any pronouncements for or against the demands.

The leadership therefore advised our notable chiefs to distance themselves from any of such barbaric arrangements with the political class of this corrupt Nation called Ghana. Our fundamental Human Rights have been trample upon for 66 years now, no progress is being made in our land for all this years and we cannot boast of any good future for our children, so we strongly advised any chief who may be tempted to make any pronouncements against our demand to be very careful.

You cannot have your citizens who have been told on countless occasions that they are strangers in this country and when the strangers decided to find their homes the same government will have them arrested and locked up for years to the extent of some dying in detention while you, their chief, will be dining with the same government.
